H.B. No. 381

1 AN ACT
2 relating to eligibility for the Texas Peace Officers' Memorial
3 Monument.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (a) A person is eligible to have the person's name on the
8 monument if the person was killed in the line of duty and was:

9 (1) a law enforcement officer or peace officer for
10 this state or a political subdivision of this state under Article
11 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, or other law;

12 (2) a federal law enforcement officer or special agent
13 performing duties in this state, including those officers under
14 Article 2.122, Code of Criminal Procedure; ~~or~~

15 (3) a corrections or detention officer or county or
16 municipal jailer employed or appointed by a municipal, county, or
17 state penal institution in this state; or


18 (4) employed by this state or a political subdivision
19 of this state and considered by the person's employer to be a
20 trainee for a position described by Subdivision (1), (2), or (3).

21 SECTION 2. (a) Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as
22 amended by this Act, applies to the eligibility of a person who was
23 killed in the line of duty before, on, or after the effective date
24 of this Act.


1 (b) The Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall
2 reconsider a nomination to have a person's name added to the Texas
3 Peace Officers' Memorial Monument under Section 3105.0035,
4 Government Code^c, if the person was determined to be ineligible
5 before the effective date of this Act and the person may be eligible
6 under Section 3105.003(a), Government Code, as amended by this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.






